A student who has cleared the Senior Secondary (+2) Examination (Academic Stream) conducted by the H.P. School Education Board or an examination accepted as equivalent there to by the various bodies of the H.P. University will be given admission strictly according to merit and reservation roster for various reserved categories of students as per the H.P. University Guidelines.

## 1 B.Sc 1st

## Provided that the Candidate

has passed the qualifying examination, i.e, $10+2$ with Science Stream shall be eligible for admission to B.Sc.

## 3 B.Com 1st

## Provided That the candidate

who has passed the qualifying examination, i.e. $10+2$ with commerce stream shall be given preference to admission to B.Com

## 2 BA 1st

Provided that the candidate who has passed the qualifying examination, i.e. $10+2$ with any stream is eligible for admission to B.A 1st

Provided that the Candidate

## GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TO BACHELOR'S DEGREE

1. Admission to various main/core subjects will be made on the recommendation of the concerned admission committee constituted for the purpose.

2 Gap of one year or more in the academic career of an applicant prior to seeking admission to the Bachelor Degree must be supported by documentary evidence or she/he has to give an undertaking as theproof of her/his activities during the period of gap
3. An Applicant must produce all the original certificates at the time of admission /counselling \&verification
4. Applicants coming from Board /University other than the H.P. Board of School Education/H.P. University must provide Migration certificate in original
5. National Open School students seeking admission to the Ist year of Bachelor Degree must have cleared all the five papers including English.
6. Physically Disabled Applicants seeking fee concession must furnish their status certificate from Medical Board.
7. Students should upload Valid documents if they wish to avail Sports and Cultural Quota.
8. Applicant availing for single girl child must furnish certificate issued by tehsildar.
9. students availing for EWS must furnish income certificate issued by tehsildar.
10. Admission of a candidate is liable to be cancelled in case she or he furnishes incomplete/false information or in case of concealment of facts. Disciplinary action will also be taken against such candidates.
11. Admission cannot be claimed as a matter of right. The Principal can deny admission to any such student whose conduct is detrimental to the interest/discipline of the institution.
12. Initially all admissions shall be provisional and subject to the final approval by SPU.
13. Failed students of other institutions shall not be admitted to any class.
14. The application must be filled by the candidate in her/his own handwriting. It should be complete in all respects and supported by the documents as mentioned above

## Checklist of Documents Required for Filling out the Admission Forms For B.A/B.Com/B.Sc 1st Year

1. Two passport Size unattested Photographs. One to be pasted on the admission form and the other one on the identity-cum-library card and are required to be attested only by the college authorities.

3. Latest Character Certificate along with school leaving certificate from the institution last attended. In case of private candidates latest character certificate by a HP Gazetted Class-I Officer or any other competent authority.
4. Self-Attested Copies of category certificate (SC/ST/OBC/EWS) if claimed.
5. Self-Attested Copies of Sports/Cultural/NCC/NSS etc. if any (At 10+2 level)
6. A certificate from the competent authority(TEHSILDAR) in case of single girl Child.
7. Bonafide Himachali certificate for fee concession (for Girl students only).
8. Migration Certificate required for the students who have passed 10+2 exam from states other than Himachal Pradesh.

Completion of a Degree:
A regular candidate shall have to undergo the prescribed courses of study in the college affiliated to the Sardar Patel University for a period not less than 3 years and a maximum of 5 years from the date of admission of the candidates. For completion of an undergraduate degree, the stud ent shall have to accumulate a minimum of 132 successful credit hours of course work.

## Outline of the Courses offered under the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) for U.G. Classes

CORE COURSE:

- Discipline Specific Core Course (DSC) of Six Credits: A core course offered by the Disciplineor Subject chosen by the candidate as the main or other Discipline/Subject. These courses aim to cover the basics that a student is expected to imbibe in a specific discipline.
- Two papers each of English and Hindi/MIL in B.A. and B. Com of Six Credits.

ELECTIVE COURSE: A Course Which A Student Can Choose From A Pool of courses Offered By A Discipline/Subject.

- Discipline Specific Core Course (DSC) of Six Credits: An elective course is a course that ischosen by a student from the courses offered by the Discipline/Subject of her or his choice. These courses are advanced courses that provide an extended scope.
- Generic Elective course (GE) of Six Credits: Any course chosen generally from other than DSC and DSC 2 for 3rd-year students with the intention to seek exposure

Note: Students of B.A. 3rd year will choose one Generic Elective Course from

1. Pol. Science 2. History 3. Economics 4. Geography 5. Hindi 6. English 7.

Music 8. Tour\& Travel

## ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COURSE:

Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) of Four Credits: These courses include Environmental Science and English/Hindi

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) of Four Credits: A course that a student studies in DSC-1 (Main Subject). They are value-based courses that aim to provide hands-on training to hone skills and competencies.

## ABOUT THE BACHELOR OF VOCATION (B.Voc.) DEGREE PROGRAMME :

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on skill development based job oriented higher education programme as a part of College/University education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) degree. This degree Programme is unique with the provision of multiple entry and exit at different levels of NSQF from level 5 to 7 ,viz. Diploma/Advance Diploma and Degree in compliance to the National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF). Multiple entry and exit will allow students the flexibility to earn and study as per their convenience.

## Course Structure:

B. Voc. programme is designed with provision for multiple exit levels. All the candidates enrolled for diploma courses or further will be treated at par from the second semester onwards. Students may exit after six months with the certificate (NSQF Level 4) or they may continue for diploma or advance diploma level courses leading to B. Voc. degree.

Following table provides a snapshot of the various certificates and their duration:-

## Eligibility Conditions :

- Admission to the B. Voc. programme will be as per the rules and regulations of the Himachal Pradesh University.
- The eligibility criteria for admission to the B. Voc. degree programme shall be 10+2 in all streams from a recognized board or an examination equivalent thereof from a Board/University established by law in India with English as a compulsory subject with $45 \%$ marks in aggregate, OR any examination of a University/Board/College or School in a foreign country recognized as equivalent for the above purpose by the Vice-Chancellor/Equivalence Committee on its own, OR on the recommendations of Association of Indian Universities with $45 \%$ marks OR as per eligibility norms of the college for admission to undergraduate courses in case of center of excellence.
- Vocational subjects under NSQF will be given weightage, equivalent to an y other general education subject while considering admission to the undergraduate courses as per reference No. DDNo.. 1 52/2013(CC/NSQF) dated 30.04.2014 of UGC.
- On 1st July 2024, a student should not be more than 23 years in case of boys and 25 years in case of girls in general category. Relaxation in case of SC/ST will be given as per university norms. The Vice Chancellor may permit age relaxation up to a maximum of six months for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- Reservation rules are applicable as per the rules or guidelines of the Himachal Pradesh Government.
- Students belonging to SC/ST category shall be given a $5 \%$ relaxation in marks for admission purpose, i.e., theywould require a minimum of $40 \%$ marks in aggregate at $10+2$ level.
- Students having compartment shall not be allowed admission in the B.Voc. programmes.
- A candidate cannot pursue two full time undergraduate courses simultaneously.
- The University reserves the right to cancel any admission at any stage.
- In matters relating to undergraduate admissions, the decision of the Admission Committee/ViceChancellor, Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla, shall be final.
- All legal matters pertaining to undergraduate admissions shall be subject to the Himachal Pradesh jurisdictiononly.
- Admission to the B.Voc. programme in Retail Management and Hospitality \& Tourism (Semester-I) shall be done purely on the merit in the qualifying examination $(10+2$ etc. $)$.
- There are three categories of candidates who shall be given admission in Semester-I of the skill-based courses under NSQF.

Category1 : Students who have already acquired NSQF certification Level 4 in a particular Industry sector may opt for admission in the skill-based courses under NSQF.
Category 2 : Students who have acquired NSQF certification Level 4, but may like to change their trade and enter into skill-based courses in a different trade.
Category 3 : Students who have passed the $10+2$ examination with conventional schooling without any background of vocational training.

Note: Regarding selection of students for B.Voc. programme, $10 \%$ extra weightage shall be given to Category- 1 and $5 \%$ extra weightage shall be given to Category-2 in 10+2 examination. Final list of students shall be decided on merit.
