
3.9 Canteen, Staff room/ Faculty room, Space for NCC, NSS, Rovers and Rangers, Examination Hall, Medical Care Facilities

Canteen

Canteen is located on ground floor of Arts Block. It has a large, naturally well-lit seating/ dining area with a capacity for approximately 90 students (31 tables each with capacity for 3 students). There is a separate cabin for teaching and non-teaching staff in the canteen. Both dining areas are equipped with wash basin. Canteen has a spacious kitchen area, a well-spaced counter, two store rooms, and a toilet. It is equipped with a CCTV camera. A large trash bin and a metallic utensil tray to collect left overs has also been installed. Canteen is regularly visited by the Canteen Committee to check quality of food and cleanliness.







Staff/ Faculty Room

Staff room/ Faculty room is located on the 1st floor of Arts Block. It has a seating capacity of 67 people. It is equipped with good quality furniture, 3 air conditioners, one computer with printer, a refrigerator, a microwave oven, and an electric kettle. CCTV control unit (DVR) has also been installed in the staffroom.







MP/ Examination Hall


Examination Hall is located on top floor of the Arts Block. It has a seating capacity for approximately 700 students, and has two entry and two exit doors. Seating area consists of eleven rows, each row having 31 benches with a seating capacity for two students per bench. There is ample space between each row to avoid crowding, and also to facilitate easy entry and exit. The Hall is efficiently ventilated and naturally well lit. Ceiling of the Examination Hall is equipped with acoustic tiles. It has two huge wall-mounted spaces (Bag Racks) on the back wall to keep belongings of students during Examination. 12 heavy duty fans have been installed on lateral walls for convenience of students during summers. It has 30 bright white LED lights installed in the ceiling for smooth conduction of examination during heavily bad weather conditions. It has a large stage area equipped with Interactive Panel, an Examination Control Room equipped with a computer, a printer, and a router for Internet Connectivity. There is a separate room for specially-abled students or for the students who come for examination with a companion. A water purifier

(Aquaguard) and a normal tap with wash basin has also been installed in the Examination Hall. The Hall is also equipped with 5 CCTV camera, 2 Fire Extinguishers, 6 wall mounted speakers, and 6 exhaust fans.






















Infirmary
