Brief Report:

On 17th Sep.2024], the Department of Economics organized a visit to Atal Sadan Auditorium for a special viewing of the play "The Doll". This initiative was part of the department's effort to promote **gender sensitization** among students. The play is known for its strong message regarding the stereotypical roles assigned to women in society, often treating them as robots—controlled, expected to perform without complaint, and stripped of their autonomy. The program aimed to expose students to creative expressions of gender related challenges how society limits women's roles and highlight the importance of gender equality.

To raise awareness about the objectification of women, the roles imposed on them by society, and the emerging threat of AI replacing human labor, including traditional roles associated with women Doll tells the story of a woman whose life is dictated by patriarchal norms, where she is expected to perform tasks and behave in a mechanical, robotic manner.

The play captures the emotional toll of this dehumanization, as the woman struggles to break free from the "programmed" expectations placed upon her
